Adult Mini Seminar – Must have passed at least one U. S. Figure Skating test.

## **COACHES**

Each skater can only register 1 coach. To be able to get a coach day pass at this seminar, coaches must meet the applicable compliance requirements and verified by U.S. Figure Skating. Details regarding compliance requirements can be found [HERE](#). All compliance requirements must be met at the time of check-in to access the seminar, no exceptions.

Coaches of foreign athletes: If you are a coach of a foreign athlete only, you are not subject to U.S. Figure Skating coach compliance and will only be asked to provide a letter of good standing for the federation your athlete represents.

Coach day pass will be refunded if 5 or more skaters register the respective coach as their primary coach.

## **REGISTRATION INFORMATION**

### **ENTRIES AND FEES**

To register online with secure credit card payment visit [seattleskatingclub.net](http://seattleskatingclub.net). **The "official" registration deadline is Saturday, May 9th at 11:59 am. However If we reach the maximum number of participants that can be accepted before the "official" entry deadline, we will close registration early.** Be sure to submit your registration as soon as possible. Late entries will be accepted only at the discretion of the LOC and will be subject to a \$50 late entry fee. Entry fees are per skater,per day in U.S. dollars.

- Seminar Registration Skaters: \$375 (Includes one Chaperone pass for each minor skater registered)
- Coach day pass: \$100 (*Coaches will need to register as if they are a skater and choose/write in themselves as the Coach during the registration process*)
- Adult Mini Seminar - \$75

### **NEW THIS YEAR**

Limited spots are available for lessons with Nathan Chen, Jean-Luc Baker, and Sam Chouniard. Pay \$10 per coach to express interest; this does not guarantee a spot. Lessons will be held on Friday, July 11th, 2025, and possibly Monday, July 14th, 2025 early morning. If selected, you'll be notified with the date and time. Pay coaching fees directly to the coach(es) and ice costs to Olympicview Arena via [Fare Harbor](#). If you do not secure a lesson, the \$10 will be refunded to your credit card.

### **ONLINE REGISTRATION VIA ENTRYEEZE**

Online registrations will be accepted via [EntryEeze](#) only. Payment must be made at the time of registration by credit card only.

The online processing fees are not refundable. Checks returned for non-sufficient funds and contested credit card charges will be issued a \$30 fee. Payment of the fee will be required

before the skater is allowed to participate in practice ice or events.
