Video Requirements

The video would need to be taken within 14 days of our submission deadline..

The skaters will introduce themself



- Skaters must introduce themselves
- Have a second phone to show date and time stamp before the test begins.
- Start video with phone in landscape mode
- Hand signal skater/music if needed to start
- Keep the skater head to toe in the center of the screen and move (and hand zoom in) to follow the skater through their test. Zoom to have the skater fill a good amount of the screen but remain in focus.
 - 1. Test is taken as one continuous videotaped sitting without stopping the video. For Moves test skater may stop between moves briefly (no more than 10 seconds) video continues to be recorded during the 10 sec.
 - 2. Test candidate must be on ice where the candidate can be clearly identified in the video and free from other skaters interfering with the test.
 - 3. No re-skates during video. If skater needs to restarts, they will have 1 chance at the end of the session.



Expect your results by email one-two week from the submission deadline. Please remember judges are volunteers and many are judging multiple test sessions and competitions, so your patience is appreciated as they review and judge your submissions.
